God's Mission

Information about the Mission Program 2009

- The following missionaries have been dropped for 2010.
 - Josh Turner (\$500/mt)-Concrete Plans for Josh's future work is uncertain.
 - Igor Egeriv (\$300/mt)-Igor is working for the University in St. Petersburg, Russia. George Miller, elder for Prestoncrest, in Dallas informed the University that we don't define working for the University to be mission work. We wanted them to guarantee 2/3 of his time be dedicated to mission work. They disagreed with this and in turn picked up all of Igor's support.
 - Mirek Bratzek in Poland (\$390/mt.) Mirek was asked by Memorial Rd. Church to move to Warsaw, Poland and take up the work there 2 years ago. Mirek was unsuccessful in this work and Memorial Rd. has terminated his support. We expect to do the same.
 - 3 native Philippine preachers we have supported for many years will be reduced by \$50/month. This will total \$150.
 - These figures total \$1340. The Missions Committee recommends an increase for the Guatemala work, the Thailand work, and the Quito, Ecuador work with some of these funds.
- The Missions Committee consists of Bill Thompson, Todd Trammel, Jonathan Sumerlin, Harold Levescy, and Lloyd Haggerty. All major decisions are made with the elders approval. The decisions of the committee are always discussed by the whole committee before they are finalized.
- Economic conditions and the fact that we are not meeting our budget assures that there will be cuts in our Missions Program this year. This is hard for the committee to accept especially since every year up to now we have added one new work every year. Won't you agree to give something additional so our budget can be met and our mission work can be resumed?
